

Volunteer Opportunities

The PTO is always in need of volunteers to help ensure full support to all the PTO programs offered to our children and teachers. Below is a list of the committees in need of volunteers. Please select the committees you would like to volunteer on.

Book Fair: The Scholastic Book Fair takes place for several days in February when students are invited to visit the Fair and purchase books. All proceeds benefit the IHM School Library. Volunteers are needed to assist students in their book selections and buying their books.

Christmas Concert Events: This committee seasonally decorates the activity center for the annual Christmas Breakfast Music Sampler and Evening Music Concert in December. As well, the committee organizes a light breakfast for the Breakfast Sampler.

Directory: At the beginning of each year, the PTO publishes a *must have* school directory. To ensure accuracy, volunteers edit the student/parent information.

Everybody Counts: This program (that takes place in February) is an age-appropriate week-long program educating the students on various physical and mental disadvantages. Volunteers are needed to help educate the students of the differences.

Field Day: This is a fun-filled day that takes place at the end of May. Volunteers are needed to make this day fun and successful.

Hospitality: This committee coordinates certain events throughout the school year. Volunteers are needed to assist with these events.

Hot Lunch Volunteers: Volunteers are needed to ensure that the students receive their hot lunch efficiently during the lunch period. The lunch program rotates through various hot lunch options. Each hot lunch has a need for six volunteers. In addition, volunteers assist with washing eco-friendly reusable plates in IHM's high-speed dishwasher on most hot lunch days.
